Tomo stood against them, alone. But looking into their eyes, she knew her friends still lay beneath the surface, captives of the vicious yokai.




Unable to fight back, Lady Tomo called out to Naka-Kon's attendees to help save her friends.

01 Nurarihyon

HT 165cm

Considered the leader of the yokai. Invites himself to busy parties and eats all the cheese. Emits such a powerful aura of leadership that even the home owners will defer to him.



02 Kitsune

HT 170cm
WT 73kg

Shape-shifting fox trickster that loves to cause mischief and confuse humans. Often associated with Inari, but not always.



03 Yuki-Onna

HT 160cm
WT 64kg

A snowy beauty who comes from the mountains. She can send you off with a blessing if you are kind to her, or freeze you with a word. Not to be confused with Elsa.



04 Ao-Andon

HT 155cm
WT 66kg

The spirit of the blue lantern. She comes out anytime scary stories are told, but no one knows what happens next.

05 Namsage

HT 173cm
WT 82kg

Seen during the First Full moon of the year, this fierce demon goes looking for naughty children. He is sent to scare bad or lazy kids into being good.



06 Kappa

HT 175cm
WT 91kg

River goblins that like sumo, cucumbers, and human innards. They are also very polite and will bow as low as you do. They are unstoppable in the water.



07 Oni

HT 183cm
WT 88kg

Large and scary with red, blue, or green skin. They wear the hides of great beasts and have horns growing out of their heads. Their greatest weakness is soy-beans.
